Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondents 4 to 6 in Opening Rowdy sheet against the petitioner in the 5<sup>th</sup> respondent

police station and thereafter transferred to the 6th respondent police station and also the action of the 6th respondent in interfering with the personal life and liberty of the petitioner by calling him regularly to the 6th respondent police station as illegal, Arbitrary, unconstitutional and Consequently quash the Rowdy sheet against the petitioner in the 6th respondent police station while making it clear to the respondents 3 to 6 that not to summon the petitioner to the 6th Respondent P.S in such casual manner without following due process of law.

**IA NO: 1 OF 2026**

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 4 to 6 not to summon the petitioner herein to the police station in the name of counselling or interfere in any manner with his personal liberty, Pending disposal of WP 8291 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.
