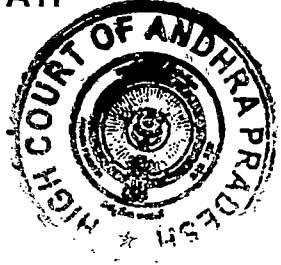

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may

be pleased to issue a Writ or Order more particularly a Writ of Mandamus declaring that the Gazette Notification published in Gazette No. 36, dt. 07.09.2018 is illegal, arbitrary and malafide and set aside the same by declaring that the State and its authorities cannot indulge in the property rights of the petitioners land to an extent of Ac. 0-67 Cents in Sy.No. 1939 situated at Nandyal Town and Mandal, Nandyal District as it is against the Articles - 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to cause any sort of interference in the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioners over their property to an extent of Ac. 0-67 Cents in Sy.No. 1939 situated at Nandyal Town and Mandal, Nandyal District pending disposal of the above writ petition.
