Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, direction or order in the nature of writ of CERTIORARI or any other appropriate writ application or order under Article 226 of the Constitution of India calling for the records on the file of the 1st Respondent and quash the Impugned Notice in ITBA/AST/S/148_1/2022-23/1051060346(1) dated 21.03.2023 u/s. 148 of the Act issued by the 1st Respondent and the Impugned Assessment Order in ITBA/AST/S/147/2023-24/1063468184(1) passed by the 1st Respondent u/s.147 of the Act dated 27.03,2024 for the Assessment Year 2016-17 as illegal and not in accordance with law.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI K.P.S. SAILESH REDDY, Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri Y.N. VIVEKANANDA, Standing Counsel for the Respondents, the Court made the following **ORDER:**
