The Court made the following ORDER:

The Writ Petition has been filed for the following relief:

“...to issue writ order or direction more particularly one in nature of the writ of mandamus declaring the inaction of the respondents 3 and 4, in taking action in pursuance of the Memorandum in RC.11356/C2/2025 Dt. 24.12.2025 and Memorandum in Rc. No 10688/C2/2025 Dt. 21.11.2025 issued by the 2nd respondent on the representation 27.10.2025 submitted by the petitioner to take action against respondents 5 and 6, as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondents to take appropriate action against respondent 5 and 6, and pass such...”

2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader.

3. Mr. T. V. S. Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that respondent Nos. 3 and 4 have not taken any action pursuant to the memorandum in RC No. 11356/C2/2025 dated 24.12.2025 and another memorandum in RC No. 10688/C2/2025 dated 21.11.2025 issued by respondent No. 2, on the representation dated 27.10.2025 submitted by the petitioner, seeking to take action against respondent Nos. 5 and 6.

4. Sri P. Ajay Babu, learned Assistant Government Pleader, on written instructions, submits that the respondent No. 4 was directed by the respondent No. 3 to conduct an enquiry based on the representation

submitted by the petitioner on 27.10.2025, and a report was submitted by respondent No. 4 to respondent No.3.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no copy of such report was furnished to the petitioner either by respondent No. 3 or respondent No. 4 for perusal and for taking appropriate action in that regard.

6. Learned Assistant Government Pleader submits that a copy of the report submitted by respondent No. 4 to respondent No. 3 is readily available with him and that he will furnish the same to the learned counsel for the petitioner. He further submits that, with regard to the representation submitted by the petitioner to the respondent police, which required consideration and appropriate action, respondent No. 3 or respondent No. 4 have not taken any action.

7. Learned Assistant Government Pleader is directed to furnish a copy of the report submitted by respondent No. 4 to respondent No. 3 to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

8. Having regard to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the writ petition is disposed of, granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge the report submitted by respondent No. 4 to respondent No. 3, in accordance with law.

7. With the above observations, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
