The Court made the following order:

The petitioners, elected Presidents of Mandal Praja Parishads, filed the above writ petition complaining the inaction of respondents in releasing the honorarium in terms of G.O.Ms.No.89 Panchayat Raj & Rural Development (PTS.III) Department, dated 07.09.2015.

Heard Sri G. Sekhar Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioners, Sri Panuku Rajesh Kumar, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Panchayat Raj appearing for respondents 1 & 2, Sri Hruthik, learned counsel representing Sri M. Sudhir, learned Standing Counsel appearing for

respondent No.3 and Ms. Usha, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the respondent authorities failed to release honorarium to the petitioners and hence, the petitioners made representations dated 06.11.2025; 10.11.2025 & 22.11.2025 to respondent No.3.

Sri Hruthik, learned counsel representing Sri M. Sudhir, learned Standing Counsel appearing for respondent No.3 submitted the communication of respondent No.2 to respondent No.3 *vide* RC.No.C7/446/2026, dated 10.04.2026.

As seen from the instructions, respondent No.3 requested the respondent No.2 to release lapsed honorarium for the financial years 2024-2025 & 2025-2026.

Given the facts and circumstances of the case, as an interim measure, respondent No.3 is directed to consider the representations made by the petitioners *vide* Ex.P1 and pass appropriate orders, within four (04) weeks from today.

List the matter after Summer Vacation, 2026.
