Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, preferably one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring the order of the Respondent No.3 in opening the suspect sheet vide C.No.33/SDOK/suspect sheet/2013 dated 24.12.2013 and continuing the suspect sheet by the Respondent No.5 vide C.No. 50/suspect/SDOC/2023 dated 23.08.2023 as illegal, arbitrary, unwarranted, unsustainable, unfair, violation of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and contrary to AP Police Standing Orders and consequently set aside the same.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to

direct the respondent police, not to call the petitioner to the police station unnecessarily and not to visit the house of the Petitioner without following due procedure established by the law, Pending disposal of WP 8267 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition/Appeal coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI SODUM ANVESHA Advocate for the Petitioner, and the Court made the following.

ORDER

In the meanwhile, the respondent authorities shall follow the procedure directed by the Hon’ble Division Bench of this Court in its order dated 12.09.2022 in I.A.No.01 of 2022 in Writ Appeal No.674 of 2022, for summoning the Petitioner to the police station on account of the pending suspect sheet.”

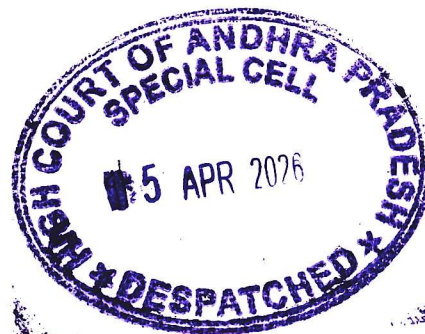
