The Criminal Petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for brevity 'the BNSS') by the Petitioner/Accused, for granting of pre-arrest bail in connection with Crime No.37 of 2026 on the file of the SHO, Pellet P.S., Tirupathi District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 351(2), 308(5), 196(1)(c), 49, 61(2), 115(1), 292, 324(3) r/w 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhitha, 2023 (for short "BNS").

2. Heard Sri B.Sesibushan Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mrs.K.Priyanka Lakshmi, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor representing on behalf of the State.

3. During the course of hearing, it is represented that this anticipatory bail application is filed directly before this Court.

4. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the petition and to file a fresh petition before the concerned Jurisdictional Court.

5. In that view of the matter, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioner is at liberty to file an application before the concerned Jurisdictional Court to work out their remedy. In the meanwhile, the respondent/State is directed not to take any coercive steps against the

petitioner for a period of three (3) weeks, to enable the petitioner to file an application before the concerned Jurisdictional Court.

As a sequel thereto, the miscellaneous applications, if any, pending in this Criminal Petition shall stand closed.
