03.	27.4.2026	<u>DR, J</u> The Writ Petition is filed assailing the orders dated 16.3.2026 of respondent no.2 under which the services of the petitioner was placed under suspension. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has mainly contended that respondent no.2 has no jurisdiction to pass the orders as his services as The Director, Animal Husbandary Dairy Development and Fisheries Department were interdicted by this Court in W.P.No.24508 of 2025 and held that the procedure for appointment of respondent no.4 is not in accordance with Rules. The said orders were passed on 29.01.2026. In the said circumstances, from the said date onwards respondent no.2 is not supposed to work in that cadre. Hence any orders passed by the said authority is to be treated as nonest in the eye of law. Reply to the said contentions, learned Government Pleader appearing on behalf of respondents, on instructions, has submitted that Government has already filed appeals against the said orders vide W.A.Nos.191 and 192 of 2026 and the said Writ Appeals are pending and the same are posted to 05.5.2026 for notices to respondents.	

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		Learned counsel has brought to the notice of the Court that no interim orders are granted by the appellate court in the Writ Appeals. When the orders of the learned single Judge is not suspended, the appointment of respondent no.2 is already declared by the coordinate Bench as contrary to rules, in the said circumstances, any orders passed by concerned authority after 29.01.2026 is to be treated as null and void and to be declared as without jurisdiction. Considering the said submissions, the impugned orders dated 16.3.2026 are suspended holding that the same is without having any jurisdiction. List the after four (04) weeks. _____ DR, J RD	

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
