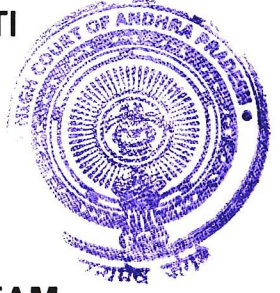

The Court made the following ORDER:

This petition is filed seeking to extend the orders already granted by this Court on 12.07.2024.

Heard the learned counsel for both parties.

For the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit, more so, as third respondent Standing Counsel Sri M.Chalapati, has not disputed the factum of granting of interim orders coupled with the fact that no counter affidavit has been filed by the 3rd respondent university in I.A.No.1 of 2026, the present petition is allowed.

Interim orders granted earlier stand extended for a period of eight (08) weeks.

Post the writ petition after two (02) weeks. Meanwhile, the 3rd respondent is directed to produce all relevant documents so far as implementation of minimum time scale in the 3rd respondent university, particularly in respect of the petitioner.

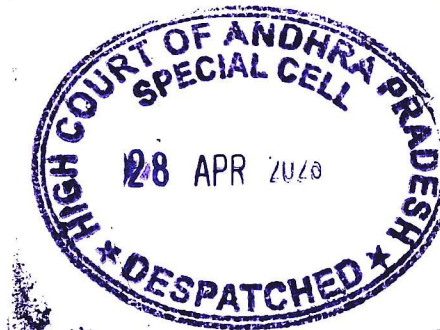
