In the course of investigation, if it is revealed that the Petitioner has also committed any offences punishable with imprisonment of more than seven years, the Investigating Officer may proceed in accordance with law.</p> <p>As the offences are compoundable in nature, Peeramsetti Purnachandra Rao, learned trained mediator, is appointed as mediator in this case.</p> <p>Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.</p> <p>Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator for amicable settlement on</p>
