Issue notice to the Respondent No.2. ✓

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. ✓

Since all the alleged offences are punishable with imprisonment of less than seven years, the Investigating Officer is directed to adhere to the procedure contemplated under Section 35(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023¹. In the course of investigation, if it is revealed that the Petitioner has also committed any offences punishable with imprisonment of more than seven years, the Investigating Officer may proceed in accordance with law. ✓

As the offences are compoundable in nature, Peeramsetti Purnachandra Rao, learned trained mediator, is appointed as mediator in this case. ✓

Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard. ✓

Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator for amicable settlement on 21.04.2026. ✓
