Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. Registry to print the name of learned Advocate General for the respondents in all the matters.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that, in similar circumstances, this Court granted an interim order, dated 13.03.2025, in W.P.No.6507 of 2025 and requested to pass a similar order in these writ petitions also. The operative portion of the said order reads as follows:

“In view of the aforesaid contentions, so as to protect the interest of both parties, this Court is inclined to order status-quo existing as on today with regard to possession of the subject property shall be maintained for a period of four (04) weeks.”

4. Hence, in view of the aforesaid order, this Court is inclined to pass a similar order in these writ petitions also.

5. Learned Government Pleader for Revenue does not refute the same.

6. Accordingly, this Court is inclined to order status-quo obtained as on today with regard to possession of the subject property till the next date of hearing.

7. Learned Government Pleader for Revenue is directed to file counter affidavit in all the matters.
