Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ or order or direction more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents more particularly the action of Respondent herein in issuing proceedings vide Rc.No.3037/2006/E2, Dt.10.03.2025 (Served

upon the Petitioner on 11.03.2025) by which the Respondents are seeking to resume the land admeasuring an extent of Ac.12.51 Cents in Sy.No.92/3 of Yendada Village, Vishakhapatnam Rural Mandal, Vishakhapatnam District, more particularly the land in Plot No.47 admeasuring 867 Sq.yds as being illegal, arbitrary, unjust, without jurisdiction, violative of Principles of Natural Justice, violative of the provisions of the Transfer of Property Act,1881, Contrary to the Order Dt.19.12.2017 of this Honble Court in W.P.Nos.36413 of 2014 and 26653 of 2015, and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India and Consequently, set aside the proceedings vide proceedings vide Rc.No.3037/2006/E2, Dt.10.03.2025 issued by the Respondent No.2;

IA NO: 1 OF 2025:

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the operation of proceedings vide Rc.No.3037/2006/E2, Dt. 10.03.2025 issued by 2nd Respondent, more 16 particularly to an extent of the land in Plot No.47 admeasuring 867 Sq.yds, pending disposal of WP.No.8337 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Kalepu Yashwanth, Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Revenue for the Respondent Nos.1 to 3 and Sri A.S.C.Bose, Standing Counsel for the Respondent No.5, the Court made the following;

ORDER:

“Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. Registry to print the name of learned Advocate General for the respondents in all the matters.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that, in similar circumstances, this Court granted an interim order, dated 13.03.2025,

in W.P.No.6507 of 2025 and requested to pass a similar order in these writ petitions also. The operative portion of the said order reads as follows:

"In view of the aforesaid contentions, so as to protect the interest of both parties, this Court is inclined to order status-quo existing as on today with regard to possession of the subject property shall be maintained for a period of four (04) weeks."

4. Hence, in view of the aforesaid order, this Court is inclined to pass a similar order in these writ petitions also.

5. Learned Government Pleader for Revenue does not refute the same.

6. Accordingly, this Court is inclined to order status-quo obtained as on today with regard to possession of the subject property till the next date of hearing.

7. Learned Government Pleader for Revenue is directed to file counter affidavit in all the matters.

8. List these matters on 29.04.2025 along with W.P.No.6507 of 2025."
