IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition Under Section 528 of B.N.S.S/Old Under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including the personal appearance of the Petitioners in CC.No. 157 of 2024, on the file of the Hon'ble Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Lakkireddypalli, Y.S.R Kadapa District, Pending disposal of CRLP 2450 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

“Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The allegation against the Petitioners, made by Respondent No.2, is that they have committed offences punishable under Sections 447, 427, and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860¹ in that they allegedly laid a road by putting gravel and thereby caused a loss of Rs.2,500/-.

Mr. T. Diwakar Reddy, learned counsel for the Petitioners, brings to the notice of this Court that an amount of Rs.50,00,000/- was sanctioned for laying the said road under the scheme of MGNREGS grant.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.157 of 2024 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Lakkireddypalli, YSR Kadapa District, until the next date of hearing.

Since the alleged offences are compoundable in nature, Mr.P.Mohan Rao, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator for amicable settlement on 21.04.2026.
