AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M.Chalapathi, Advocate for the Petitioners and Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 3 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds of criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further in SC No 383 of 2025, on the file VII Additional District Sessions Judge at Peddapuram, Kakinada District, and State of Andhra Pradesh, pending disposal of CRLP No.3659 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The presence of the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 to 9 is dispensed with before the learned Trial Court unless it is otherwise required.

Having regard to the nature of the allegations leveled by Respondent No.2 against the Petitioners, and also considering the fact that some of the Petitioners have not played any active role in the commission of the alleged offence, as well as the ingredients of Section 306 of 'the I.P.C.,' which are not squarely applicable to the majority of the Petitioners, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mrs.Jyothi Lakshmi Midthipati, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings against the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 and 9 in S.C.No.383 of 2025 on the file of the learned VII Additional District and Sessions Judge, Peddapuram, Kakinada District.
