**ORDER:**

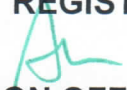
In spite of there being a direction there is no appearance for Petitioner and Respondent No.2.

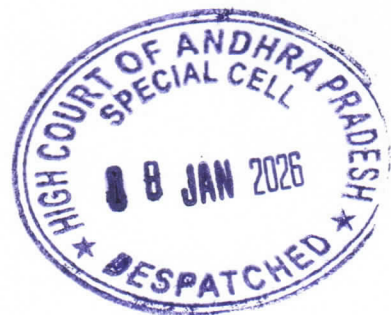
