WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate Sri Doddaka Harsha Vardhan, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ or Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of Respondent Nos.2 to 4 in not taking steps to re open/continue the Rowdy Sheet No. 24 (C.No.154/Rowdy-SDOC/2023) maintained against Respondent No. 6 herein on the file of Chinnaganjam Police Station, Chinnaganjam Mandal, Bapatla District, despite the representation/complaint dated 12.02.2026 made by the petitioner, as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violative of Article 14, 21 of Constitution of India, Consequently direct Respondent Nos.2 to 4 to open the rowdy sheet against the 6th respondent herein by considering the petitioners representation dated 12.02.2026.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Doddaka Harsha Vardhan, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP for Home for Respondent Nos. 1 to 5, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
