01.	31.03.2026	<p><u>DR, J</u></p> <p>Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.</p> <p>The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent No.6 through RPAD and file proof of service before the registry.</p> <p>The grievance of the petitioners is that the respondents are proposing to release the pension and other retirement benefits to the 6th respondent based on fake and forged documents. It is the specific case of the petitioners that they are the legal heirs of the deceased employee. In support of their claim, the petitioners have already filed S.O.P. No.16 on the file of the learned Principal Senior Civil Judge, Nellore, seeking appropriate relief. In the said O.P., the 6th respondent has been impleaded as a party respondent and is contesting the matter. While the said O.P. is still pending adjudication before the competent civil court, the respondents are proceeding to release</p>	

the pensionary and retirement benefits to the 6th respondent, as is evident from their proceedings dated 24.03.2026.

Considering the said circumstances, this Court is of the view that appropriate directions are required to be issued. Accordingly, the respondents, more particularly respondent Nos.3 to 5, are directed not to release the pensionary and retirement benefits in favour of the 6th respondent until further orders.

For filing counter, post the matter after four (04) weeks.
