Petition Under Section 528 of B.N.S.S/Old Under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings in F.I.R. No. 246 of 2025, dated 13.06.2025 on the file of Mangalagiri Rural Police Station, Mangalagiri, Guntur District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 2466 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The alleged offences levelled against the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 to 3 are punishable with imprisonment for less than seven (07) years.

In the meanwhile, the Investigating Officer is directed to issue a notice contemplated under Section 35(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for brevity, ‘the BNSS’). However, the petitioners are directed to cooperate with the Investigating Officer, and the Investigating Officer may proceed with further investigation.

The matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.MD.Mujubyuddin, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 21.04.2026 and cooperate with the mediation proceedings for an amicable settlement of the issue.

Post on 05.05.2026 for Mediator's report.

List this Criminal Petition along with CrI.P.No.262 of 2026."

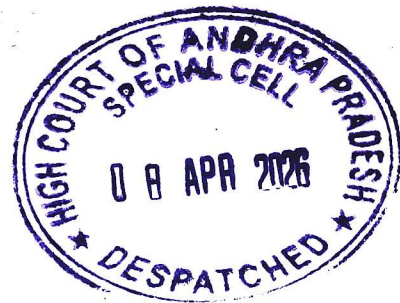
