		District Judge, Rajamahendravaram, seeking custody of the twin daughters, who are presently with respondent No.1. Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation. Sri Pitani Chandrasekhar Reddy, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case. The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard. The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time. The petitioners and Respondent No.1 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 06.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator. The learned trained mediator is also directed to conduct mediation in H.M.O.P.No.424 of 2024 and Guardian O.P.No.84 of 2024. The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement. Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.
