Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. (under section 482 of Cr.P.C), is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant STAY of all further proceedings including appearance of the Petitioners in D.V.C. No. 91 of 2024 V Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, (erstwhile East Godavari

District), pending disposal of CRLP No. 3260 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.1.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.1 and file proof to that effect.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the husband has filed H.M.O.P. No.424 of 2024 on the file of the learned Principal Additional Senior Civil Judge, Kakinada, seeking restitution of conjugal rights. The husband has also filed Guardian O.P. No.84 of 2024 on the file of the learned Principal District Judge, Rajamahendravaram, seeking custody of the twin daughters, who are presently with respondent No.1.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri Pitani Chandrasekhar Reddy, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.1 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 06.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator. The learned trained mediator is also directed to conduct mediation in H.M.O.P.No.424 of 2024 and Guardian O.P.No.84 of 2024.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in D.V.C.No.91 of 2024 on the file of the learned V Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Kakinada.
