Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ or order more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents especially respondent No.3 to 5 in interfering with the petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment of their respective house sites totally admeasuring Ac.0.16.5 cents in Survey No.555-3 situated at Mandalapalli Revenue Village and Gram Panchayat, Gorantla Mandal, Sri Sathya Sai District, as illegal, arbitrary, against the principles of natural justice and also without following due procedure and consequently direct the respondent No.3 to 5 not to interfere with the petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment of their respective house sites totally admeasuring Ac.0.16.5 cents in Survey No.555-3 situated at Mandalapalli Revenue Village and Gram Panchayat, Gorantla Mandal, Sri Sathya Sai District.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be

pleased to direct the respondent No.3 to 5 not to interfere with the petitioners' peaceful possession and enjoyment of their respective house sites totally admeasuring Ac.0.16.5 cents in Survey No.555-3 situated at Mandalapalli Revenue Village and Gram Panchayat, Gorantla Mandal, Sri Sathya Sai District, Pending disposal of WP 8504 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri G. Venkateshwarlu, learned counsel representing Sri Seshadri Goalla Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR PANCHAYAT RAJ RURAL DEV for the Respondent Nos.1 & 2, GP FOR REVENUE for respondent No.4, Sri S.Hruthik, learned counsel representing Sri M.Sudhir, Standing Counsel for respondent nos.3 & 5, GP FOR REVENUE for respondent No.4, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Government Pleader for Panchayat Raj takes notice for respondents 1 and 2.

Sri M. Sudhir, learned standing counsel takes notice and offers to file vakalat for respondents 3 and 5.

Learned Government Pleader for Revenue takes notice for respondent No.4.

Heard Sri G. Venkateshwarlu, learned counsel representing Sri Seshadri Goalla, learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners 1 to 3 are in possession and enjoyment of Ac.0.4 cents of land, each and petitioners 4 to 6 are in possession and enjoyment of Ac.0.01.5 cents of land, each in survey No.555-3, Mandalapalli Revenue Village and Gram Panchayat, Gorantla Mandal, Sri Sathya Sai District.

Respondent No.4-Tahsildar issued possession certificates and copies of said certificates are filed as Exs.P1 to P6. Learned counsel would submit that respondents 3 to 5 are trying to dispossess from their respective lands, without following the due process of law.

Sri S.Hruthik, learned counsel representing Sri M. Sudhir, learned standing counsel for respondents 3 and 4 and Ms. P. Usha, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, for respondent No.5 seek time to get instructions.

Post on 07.04.2026.

In the mean time, respondents 3 to 5 shall not interfere with the petitioners' possession and enjoyment of their respective lands, mentioned supra, without following the due process of law. Date: 31.03.2026
