Civil

No.50 of 2025 and not passing any orders on the representation of the Petitioner dated 17-03-2026 and 20-03-2026 and not taking any action against the unofficial Respondents for their illegal attempt of dispossession and interference in the subject land of the Petitioner, as illegal, arbitrary, violation of . Principles of Natural Justice, violation of Articles 14, 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the Respondent No.3 to give Police protection to the Petitioner's land admeasuring Ac.3.78 cents situated in Sy. No.370/5, Devaragudipalli Village, Vedurukuppam Mandal, Tirupati District.
