Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction preferably a Writ in the nature of Mandamus declaring the entire land acquisition proceedings initiated against the petitioners for acquiring land ad measuring Ac.23.14 cents in Survey No.78-1P of the 1st petitioner and the land admeasuring Ac.14.01 Cents in Survey No. 78-1P belonging to 2nd petitioner in Gudepuvalasa village, Bhogapuram Mandal as lapsed, illegal, arbitrary, high handed and violative of Section 25 and provisions of Act 30 of 2013 Act, Articles 14, 21 of the Constitution of India and pass such other order or orders in the interest of justice. And further declare passing of Award No 70-1/2016/SDT dated 04.11. 2022 after lapse of the time period prescribed under Section 25 of the Act 30 of 2013 Act is illegal, arbitrary and invalid and direct the Respondents to redeliver the possession of land admeasuring Ac.23.14 cents in Survey No.78-1P of the 1st petitioner and the land admeasuring Ac.14.01 Cents in Survey No.78-1P belonging to 2nd petitioner in Gudepuvalasa Village, Bhogapuram Mandal to the respective petitioners as all the proceedings are vitiated and lapsed;

**Prayer is amended as per the Court's order dt: 22.11.2024 in IA.No.1 of 2024 in Writ Petition and affidavit.**

**IA NO: 1 OF 2023:**

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings pursuant to the issuance of Preliminary Notification Rc.No.2314/2015/G3 dated 31.08.2015 under Section 11(1), Final Notification/Declaration Rc.No.2314/2015/G3 dated 02.05.2016 under section 19 and the General Award No.70-1/2016/SDT dated 04.11.2022 under sections 23 and 30 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, pending disposal of WP.No.8782 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Prakash Buddarapu, Advocate for the Petitioners and GP for Energy for the Respondent Nos.1 & 2 and GP for Revenue for the Respondent Nos.4 to 6, the Court made the following;

**ORDER:**

**“Learned Senior Counsel would submit that as there is collusion in between the official respondents and unofficial 9<sup>th</sup> respondent, unofficial 9<sup>th</sup> respondent is avoiding service of notice residing in the address mentioned in the writ petition.**

**Therefore, both the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader is directed to service notice on the 9<sup>th</sup> respondent on either mode of service.**
