ORAL ORDER:

Heard Sri K. Ranga Srinivas, learned Counsel representing Sri Kode Ramesh Babu, learned Counsel for the Writ Petitioner, Ms. K. Siva Jyothi, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Finance & Planning and Smt. Sireesha Rani Vallabhaneni, learned Standing Counsel for Municipalities.

2. Smt. Sireesha Rani Vallabhaneni, learned Standing Counsel for Municipalities has submitted the Written Instructions furnished by the Commissioner of Tenali Municipal Corporation, dated 09.04.2026. Copy of it is supplied to the Counsel for the Petitioner and the same is taken on record.

3. Smt. Sireesha Rani Vallabhaneni, learned Standing Counsel for Municipalities, requests six (06) weeks' time for clearing the due amount to the Petitioner.

4. This Court, finding the request to be reasonable, deems it appropriate to allow this Writ Petition with a direction to all the Respondents to complete the entire Administrative process, both inter-departmental and intra-departmental,

by way of mutual co-operation and coordination, within a period of four (04) weeks from today and transfer the due amount to the bank account of the Writ Petitioner within two (02) weeks thereafter.

5. The Writ Petitioner is directed to submit the bank account details to the Competent Authority within two (02) weeks from today for effective compliance.

6. With these observations and directions, the Writ Petition is allowed. No order as to costs.

7. Interlocutory Applications, if any, stand closed in terms of this order.
