IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings to the Petitioners in CC. No. 178 of 2026 on the file of 2nd Additional Judicial Magistrate of 1st Class, Kadapa for the offences punishable under Section 85, 351(2) r/w 3(5) of BNS and Section 3 & 4 of D.P. Act, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3426 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioners are the old-aged in-laws and relatives of the husband of Respondent No.2. The Respondent No.2 and Accused No.1 got married on 18.08.2021, and they were blessed with a female child.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.D.Kishore Kumar, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.178 of 2026 on the file of the learned II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kadapa.
