Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ order or direction more in the nature of Mandamus by declaring the registration of report which was reduced into writing by a Woman constable upon the dictation of 5th Respondent by diluting the seriousness of the offences committed by Respondents 12 to 14 as F.I.R.No.187 of 2025 dated 12.11.2025 on the file of 1 Town Police Station, Gudivada, Krishna District is not a First Information Report of the Petitioner dated 31.10.2025, as such the charge sheet i.e., C.C.No.111 of 2026 filed by 7th Respondent before learned Additional Judicial Magistrate of 1st Class Court, Gudivada, Krishna District is invalid, nonest in the eyes of law, amounts



to abuse the powers of Respondents 5 to 8 by mis-using their official capacity with an intention to harbouring the Respondents 12 to 14 to screen them from the legal punishment for the offences actually committed by them, so also the inaction on part of Respondents 4 to 8 in registering the report of the Petitioner dated 31.10.2025 as an F.I.R and conducting investigation upon the report by an authorized police officer for the offences actually committed by Respondents 12 to 14, is deliberate, clear defiance of law, illegal, arbitrary, irregular, irrational, under involvement of influential persons and also against to the Judgment of Supreme Court in Lalita Kumari Vs State of U.P as well as the Notification issued by Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India vide No. 15011/91/2013-SC/ST-W, Dated 12.10.2015 and 6.02.2014 and violation of Article 14, 19 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently order for investigation of the case by an independent Investigating Agency other than A.P.State police upon the report of the Petitioner dated 31/10/2025 which was given against Respondents 12 to 14 including to investigate against Respondents 9 to 11 under the provisions of BNS for the offences committed by them, as well as direct Respondent No.1 to initiate administrative enquiry against Respondents 9 to 11 for their wilful negligent conduct of their official duties as Respondents 5, 6 and 8 respectively to proceed further under the provisio of Section 4(2) of SC and ST (POA) Act.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to order by directing Respondents No. 5 and 6 to produce the C.C.T.V. footages of entire 1 Town Police Station, Gudivada, Krishna District as well as the C.C.T.V footage of office of Respondent No.6 respectively from 31.10.2025 to 5.01.2026 to this Hon'ble Court

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.111 of 2026 on the file of Additional Judicial Magistrate of 1st Class Court, Gudivada, Krishna District, Pending disposal of WP No.12774 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Bala Krishna Sastry, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP for Home for the Respondent Nos. 1 to 8, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner gave a complaint on 31.10.2025 to the Station House Officer, Gudivada I Town Police Station, the same was not registered. Thereafter, on 01.11.2025, he approached the Superintendent of Police under PGRS and submitted a detailed complaint.

However, the police have registered a case on the instructions of the higher authorities on 13.11.2025 but changing the entire contents of the complaint. Basing on the said changed complaint, the respondent police registered the present Crime No.187 of 2025. Aggrieved by the same, the petitioner approached this Court making several allegations and also sought preservation of the CCTV footage dated 31.10.2025 at I Town Police Station, Gudivada.

Therefore, the respondent police are directed to preserve the CCTV footage of I Town Police Station, Gudivada dated 31.10.2025. In the meantime, the respondent authorities shall file their counter.
