3. In additional to the normal mode of service, the appellant is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent by registered post and acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry before the next date of listing.

4. List on 24.06.2026.

5. Till the next date of listing, the decree shall remain stayed and the parties shall not remarry.

6. On the appearance of respondent, the Court will consider to refer the parties to mediation.
