WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI S M SUBHAN presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in wrong calculation of pensionable pension to the petitioner on higher wage on pro-rata basis as per the provisions of EPS-1995, is unconstitutional, Contrary to the provisions of Pension Rules, and violative of principles of natural justice
