Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action on part of Respondents No. 4 to 6 in interfering and conducting a re-survey of my peaceful possession and enjoyment over the land an extent of Ac.2.71 cents

in Sy.No.309/2 and Ac.0.30 cents in Sy.No.310/2 at Peddhapudilla Village, Peapully Mandal, Dhone Division, Nandyal District with an ulterior motive to alter the boundaries already settled in favour of the respondent No.7 as arbitrary, illegal, colorable exercise of power and contrary to the well established legal principles being laid down in Andhra Pradesh Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923 and apart from being violative of the Fundamental and Constitutional Rights guaranteed to me under Articles 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere into my peaceful possession and enjoyment over the land an extent of Ac.2.71 cents in Sy.No.309/2 and Ac.0.30 cents in Sy .No.310/2 at Peddhapudilla Village, Peapully Mandal, Dhone Division;

**IA NO: 1 OF 2026:**

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent.No.4 to 6 not to interfere and conduct resurvey of my peaceful possession and enjoyment over the land an extent of Ac.2.71 cents in Sy.No.309/2 and Ac.0.30 cents in Sy.No.310/2 at Peddhapudilla Village, Peapully Mandal, Dhone Division, without following due process of law, pending disposal of WP.No.10302 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri B.Abhay Siddhanth Mootha, Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Revenue for the Respondent Nos.1 to 6, the Court made the following;
