WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri MUNNANGI THANMAI KRISHNA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass a writ order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of respondents 3 to 6 in not considering the representations of the petitioner dated 04-01- 2026, 28-01-2026 and 11.03.2026, and not taking action in pursuance thereof, against respondents 7 and 8 who are fraudulently receiving widow pensions, though their husbands are alive as illegal, unlawful, arbitrary and violative of pension laws and also violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondent authorities to conduct enquiry into the fraudulent widow pension claims of respondents 7 and 8 and to stop the widow pensions of respondents 7 and 8 forthwith and order for recovery of the pension amounts taken by respondents 7 and 8 from the date of issuance till the date of cancellation and to initiate appropriate legal action against respondents 7 and 8 in the interests of justice;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Munnangi Thanmai Krishna, Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Panchayat Raj & Rural Development Department for Respondent No.1 and GP for Revenue Department for Respondent Nos.2 to 4 and Sri Y.Koteswararao, Standing Counsel for Respondent Nos.5 & 6, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Learned government Pleader for Panchayat Raj & Rural Development Department takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

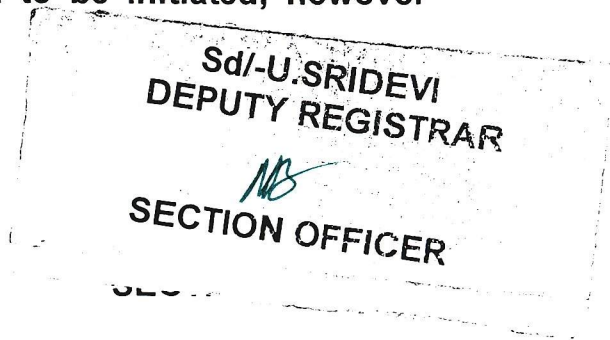
Learned Government Pleader for Revenue Department takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.2 to 4.
