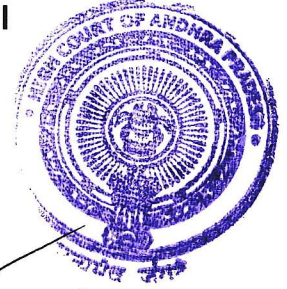

WHEREAS the Appellant above named through her Advocate Sri. P N MURTHY, presented this Appeal under Section 19 of the Family Courts Act, having been aggrieved by the Decree and Order in F.C.OP.No. 306 of 2022 on the file of Court of the Judge, Family Court Cum - VII Additional District Court, Anantapuramu, dt15-03-2026;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P N MURTHY, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent herein to show cause as to why this FAMILY COURT APPEAL (FCA) should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this FAMILY COURT APPEAL (FCA) should not be admitted on or before **16.06.2026** to which date the case stands posted for hearing.

Petition under Section 151 CPC., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant interim suspension of the Order and Decree in F.C.OP.No. 306 of 2022 on the file of Court of the Judge, Family Court - Cum - VII Additional District Court, Anantapuramu, dt: 15-03-2026, pending disposal of the CMA;

The Court made the following ORDER:

The appeal has been filed by the wife, being aggrieved from the decree of divorce granted in the petition filed by the husband/respondent, seeking divorce under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act.

2. Issue notice to the respondent.
3. In addition to the normal mode of service, the appellant is permitted to take out personal notice by Registered Post with Acknowledgement Due and file proof of service by the next date.
4. List on 16.06.2026.

5. Considering the submissions advanced as also the consequences vide from the divorce decree, we stay operation of the decree of divorce and the parties shall not remarry, till the next date of listing.

6. After the appearance of the respondent, the Court would consider to refer the parties for mediation.

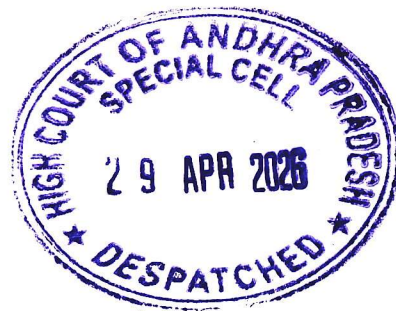
