This Criminal Revision Case has been filed aggrieved by the Calendar and Judgment dated 24.06.2019 passed in CrI.A.No.126 of 2017 on the file of the Court of learned XVI Additional District & Sessions Judge, Nandigama, Krishna District, confirming the conviction and the sentence imposed in Calendar and Judgment dated 10.03.2017 passed in C.C.No.345 of 2016 on the file of the Court of learned Judicial I Class Magistrate, Jaggaiahpet.

2. Heard Sri Kambhampati Ramesh Babu, learned Counsel for the Petitioner and Mrs. K.Priyanka Lakshmi, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the State.

3. Since there was an element of settlement in the matter, this Court, vide Order dated 27.01.2026, referred the dispute to the High Court Legal Services Committee for mediation. The Petitioner/Accused and the defacto Complainant are present before this Court, and this Court has received the Mediation Report stating that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties. It is submitted that the Petitioner/Accused has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) towards permanent alimony to the defacto Complainant, and the defacto Complainant has agreed to receive the said amount towards full and final settlement of her claim. Both parties have further agreed to dissolve their marriage by way of divorce by mutual

consent, and the defacto Complainant has expressed that she has no objection to recording the compromise in this matter.

4. During the proceedings before this Court, the Petitioner has paid the amount of Rs.1,00,000/- to the defacto complainant. She has received that amount.

5. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor would submit that the Court may pass appropriate orders.

6. In that view of the matter, the Criminal Revision Case is allowed, in the light of the terms agreed in the mediation. Accordingly, the Judgment dated 24.06.2019 passed in CrI.A.No.126 of 2017 on the file of the Court of learned XVI Additional District & Sessions Judge, Nandigama, Krishna District, confirming the conviction and the sentence imposed in Calendar and Judgment dated 10.03.2017 passed in C.C.No.345 of 2016 on the file of the Court of learned Judicial I Class Magistrate, Jaggaiahpet is hereby set aside. Accordingly, the Petitioner/Accused is acquitted.

Consequently, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
