This Criminal Revision Case has been filed aggrieved by the Calendar and Judgment dated 13.09.2024 passed in CrI.A.No.370 of 2019 on the file of the Court of learned XI Additional Sessions Judge, Tenali, confirming the conviction and the sentence imposed in Calendar and Judgment dated 28.08.2019 passed in C.C.No.180 of 2017 on the file of the Court of learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tenali.

2. Heard Sri Petluri Naga Raju, learned Counsel for the Petitioner, Mrs. K.Priyanka Lakshmi, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the State and Mrs. Marella Radha, learned counsel representing for the respondent/complainant.

3. The Petitioner/accused and the complainant are present before this Court and submitted that they have compromised the matter amicably. The Complainant submits that the Petitioner/Accused and the 2nd Respondent/Complainant had agreed before this Court on 03.02.2026 that the Petitioner/Accused would pay a total sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only), being the cheque amount, to the 2nd Respondent/Complainant towards full and final settlement of the case. It is further submitted that the Petitioner/Accused paid a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- before this Court on 03.02.2026, and the remaining amount of Rs.2,50,000/- has been paid to the Complainant today. The Complainant acknowledges receipt of the entire agreed amount and has filed a memo to that effect before this Court.

4. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor would submit that the Court may pass appropriate orders.

5. In that view of the matter, the Criminal Revision Case is allowed in terms of compromise, subject to the payment of an amount of Rs.10,000/- towards costs, to the High Court Legal Services Committee by the Petitioner/Accused. The Secretary is directed to spend this amount for the welfare of the visually challenged children to attend their necessities if any.

6. Accordingly, the Judgment dated 13.09.2024 passed in CrI.A.No.370 of 2019 on the file of the Court of learned XI Additional Sessions Judge, Tenali, confirming the conviction and the sentence imposed in Calendar and Judgment dated 28.08.2019 passed in C.C.No.180 of 2017 on the file of the Court of learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tenali are hereby set aside subject to payments of costs. Accordingly, the Petitioner/Accused is acquitted.

Consequently, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
