No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. (under section 482 of Cr.P.C), , is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioner in C.C. No. 988 of 202³ on the file of the II Addl. Judicial First Class Magistrate, Machilipatnam, Krishna District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 2781 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The alleged offences are compoundable in nature. The allegation against the petitioner/Accused by respondent No.2 is

that he issued a cheque drawn on SBH, which was later merged into SBI.

The matter is referred to mediation.

Ms. Uma Devi Manchala, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The petitioner and respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 30.04.2026 and cooperate with the mediation proceedings for an amicable settlement of the issue.

Post on 07.05.2026 for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.988 of 2026 on the file of the learned II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Machilipatnam, including the appearance of the petitioner/Accused.
