

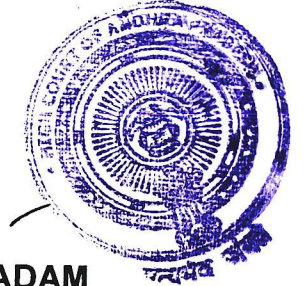

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents in not acquiring and paying compensation to the petitioner in respect of the land an extent of Ac:0-69 cents in S.No.1922 of Nellore Bit-I village as per the Act 30 of 2013 the Proceedings Rc.G1/4248/2008, dated 02.06.2022 of the 2nd respondent as illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Article 300A of Constitution of India and Consequently direct the 2nd

respondent to finalize the land acquisition proceedings and pay the compensation to the petitioner in respect of the land in S.No. 1922 an extent of Ac.0-69 cents of Nellore Bit-I village.

Prayer is amended as per the Order of this Court, dt.23.08.2023, vide order passed in I.A.1 of 2023.

IA NO: 1 OF 2019:

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to finalize the acquisition proceedings and pay compensation to the petitioner in respect of the land Ac.0-69 cents in S.No. 1922 of Nellore Bit-I village as per the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013, pending disposal of WP.No.7992 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court order dated 02.05.2022 & 02.02.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri C.Subodh, Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Revenue for Respondent Nos.1 to 3 and GP for Municipal Administration & Urban Development for Respondent No.4, the Court made the following;

ORDER:

In continuation of the proceedings dt.02.02.2026, the 3rd respondent appeared before this Court in person. However, the 3rd respondent has not explained the reasons for fixing the compensation based on the market value of 2008, which contradicts the proceedings issued by the 2nd respondent on 30.04.2017.

Therefore, the 2nd respondent is directed to appear before this Court on the next date of hearing.

List the matter on 19.02.2026.
