Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondent authorities in issuing the order of removal from service vide D.O. No. 344/2022 dated 01.04.2022 and also the action of the 3rd respondent in rejecting the petitioners appeal vide ROO. No. 221/2025 dated 28.06.2025, as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India

apart from violation of ARCS CCA rules and consequently direct the respondents to set aside the order of removal dated 01.04.2022 in the light of the fact that the departmental enquiry was conducted ex-parte and reinstate the petitioner with all consequential benefits, in the interest of justice;
