When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel representing the appellant/accused and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing the respondent–State submitted that the appellant/accused had passed away on 02.03.2024 during the pendency of the appeal.

2. In this regard, the prosecution has placed on record the Death Certificate of the appellant/accused, issued on 13.03.2024 by the Department of Health, Medical and Family Welfare, Grama Panchayat, Chinnakotla.
