WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI RAMALAKSHMANA REDDY SANEPALLI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to Issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order, or Direction declaring the actions of Respondent Nos. 3 to 6 in interfering with the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the

subject property, despite the subsistence of an ad-interim injunction order in I.A. No. 656 of 2024 in O.S. No. 337 of 2024 on the file of the Hon'ble Principal Junior Civil Judge, Tiruvuru, as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction, and violative of Articles 14, 19, and 300-A of the Constitution of India and Consequently, direct Respondent Nos. 3 to 6 not to interfere, directly or indirectly, with the petitioner's possession and enjoyment of the land admeasuring Ac. 0.58 cents in R.S. No. 38/1 of Lakshmipuram Revenue Village, Tiruvuru Mandal.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri RAMALAKSHMANA REDDY SANEPALLI Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Home Department Respondent Nos.1 to 4, GP for Revenue for Respondent Nos.5 & 6, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.7 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
