The Court made the following ORDER:

This appeal has been filed by the wife. The respondent/husband filed the petition for dissolution of the marriage, which has been allowed by the learned Principal District Judge, West Godavari at Eluru, on the ground of desertion.

2. Issue notice to the respondent. ✓

3. In addition to the normal mode of service, the appellant is permitted to take out personal notice by Registered Post with Acknowledgement Due and file proof of service by the next date. ✓

4. List on 08.05.2026. ✓

5. Considering the submissions advanced as also the consequences vide from the divorce decree, we stay operation of the

decree of divorce and the parties shall not remarry, till the next date of listing.

6. After the appearance of the respondent, the Court would consider to refer the parties for mediation.
