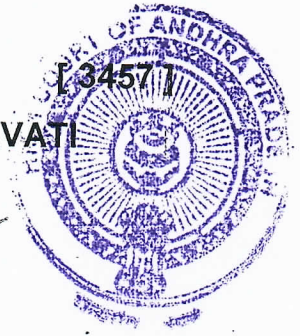

ORDER

“The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are arraigned as accused Nos.3 to 6 in C.C.No.1179 of 2025 on the file of IV Special Judicial Magistrate of First Class for Excise, Guntur, for alleged offences under Sections 498-A, 324,354(a), 506 read with 34 of IPC and Section 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act. It is submitted that the petitioners are completely unconnected with the marital disputes between the 1st accused and the 2nd respondent and are living separately. However, they have been roped in as accused only to harass the petitioners. ✓

Considering the submissions, there shall be stay of appearance of the petitioners in C.C.No.1179 of 2025 on the file of IV Special Judicial Magistrate of First Class for Excise, Guntur, except for the dates when they are required for the purpose of trial.”
