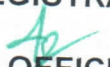
ORDER:

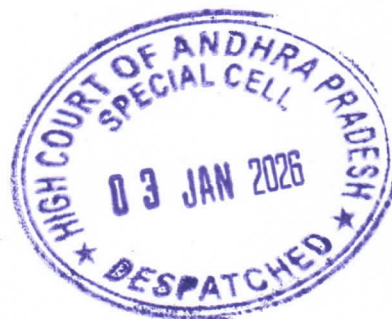
