The Court made the following:

ORDER:

The Writ Petition has been filed for the following relief:

“...to issue a Writ of Mandamus declaring the actions of Respondents 5 and 6 in refusing to register an FIR and using abusive language against the Petitioner as illegal, and consequently direct Respondents No.3 to 6 A) To register the FIR against Respondent No.7 and his associates based on the Petitioner's complaints and conduct a fair investigation B) To initiate disciplinary action against the 6th Respondent for the use of unparliamentarily language against a complainant within station precincts...”

2. Heard the learned counsel for Petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader.

3. Mr. Alla Rama Krishna, learned counsel for the Petitioner, submits that Respondent Nos.5 and 6 have refused to register the First Information Report (FIR) based on the Petitioner's complaints against Respondent No.7 and his associates. It is further submitted that Respondent No.6, within the precincts of the Police Station, used abusive and unparliamentary language against the

Petitioner, which amounts to misconduct and violates the dignity and rights of a complainant.

4. *Per contra*, Sri P. Ajay Babu, learned Assistant Government Pleader, submits that the Petitioner's complaint was duly considered through a preliminary enquiry. It was found therein that certain monetary disputes are pending between the Petitioner and Respondent No.7. Consequently, the Respondent Police advised both the parties to approach the competent civil court for appropriate relief. It is further submitted that the Respondent No.6 never used abusive or unparliamentary language against the Petitioner, and that the allegation of misconduct is baseless and unsupported by any independent evidence.

5. Be that as it may, the Petitioner has got an alternative efficacious remedy by filing a private complaint before the learned Jurisdictional Magistrate under Section 190 read with Section 200 of 'the Cr.P.C.,'/Section 210 read with Section 223 of 'the BNSS'.

6. Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, and recording the submissions of the learned Assistant Government Pleader, the Writ Petition is disposed of, requiring the Petitioner to approach the learned Jurisdictional Magistrate by way of filing an appropriate complaint under Section 190 read with Section 200 of 'the Cr.P.C.,'/Section 210 read with Section 223 of 'the BNSS', if so advised.

7. With the above observations and directions, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall stand closed.
