ORER:

The Criminal Petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity 'the Cr.P.C.)/Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for brevity 'the BNSS'), seeking relaxation of the condition imposed on the Petitioner by order dated

06.01.2026 in Crl.M.P.No.1361 of 2025 in Crime No.30 of 2025 of Gudem Kothaveedhi Police Station, passed by the learned I Additional District & Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge for Trial of Offences under the NDPS Act, Visakhapatnam (for brevity, 'the learned Trial Court'), to the extent of the condition requiring the furnishing of a Bank Guarantee for Rs.3,50,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only), and further praying for release of the vehicle on furnishing lesser security or bond.

2. The learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that the financial condition of the Petitioner is deplorable and he is unable to comply with the conditions imposed by the learned Trial Court.

3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. Perused the record.

4. Considering the above circumstances, the order dated 06.01.2026 in Crl.M.P.No.1361 of 2025 in Crime No.30 of 2025 of Gudem Kothaveedhi Police Station, passed by 'the learned Trial Court' against the Petitioner, is hereby modified to the extent that the Petitioner shall furnish a Bank Guarantee for an amount of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Only), while all other conditions imposed by 'the learned Trial Court' in the original order shall remain in force and shall be duly complied with by the Petitioner.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.
