1.	29.04.2026	<u>RNT, J&BM, J</u> This appeal has been filed by the wife, aged about 74 years, challenging the decree of divorce granted on the petition of the husband/respondent, presently aged about 77 years. 2. The petition for divorce was filed in the year 2022. 3. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the parties were married on 14.05.2003 and this was the second marriage of the respondent/husband. He further submits that previously also the petition for divorce and also for restitution of conjugal rights were filed by the respective parties. Previously, a case under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 was filed by the wife. As per the submission advanced by the learned counsel for the appellant, there appears to be some settlement between the parties under which the wife received certain amount but all the terms were not complied with and after receiving the money, the wife did not turn up in the proceedings for divorce by mutual consent, which was dismissed for that reason. 4. Considering the aforesaid submissions, but without observing anything on the merits of those submissions, at this stage, no case for grant of an
