affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of a writ of mandamus to declare the action of 1st Respondent University in passing the rejection orders for compassionate appointment vide Proc. No.S.III(1)/0883/2002(464A)/2025 dated 19-12-2025 as arbitrary, illegal, and violative of GOMs.No. 350 (GAD) dated 30-07-1999, Government Memo No.406/10/A/Admn,11/2004, Fin. (Admn.II) dated 20-03-2004, law laid down by Apex Court in V. GANGA KUMAR, Advocate for the Respondent No.1 and of GP FOR HIGHER EDUCATION, for the Respondent No.2, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.3, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
