1.	21.04.2026	<u>GRKP, J</u> Heard Sri V. Pawan Kumar, learned Counsel appearing for the Writ Petitioner and Sri G. Lakshmi Narayana, learned Standing Counsel for Municipalities. 2. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner has drawn the attention of this Court to the Representation submitted by him on 30.03.2026 (Ex.P.5). He has also taken this Court through the Photocopies. 2. Sri G. Lakshmi Narayana, learned Standing Counsel for Municipalities appearing for Respondent Nos.2 & 3, has submitted the Written Instructions furnished by the Commissioner dated 20.04.2026. Copy of it is supplied to the Counsel for the Petitioner and the same is taken on record. 3. The Written Instructions would indicate that the drainage water was originally flowing through private land belonging to Sri T. Venkataiah. The Written Instructions would also indicate that if a proper and permanent drainage is to be laid through public land, it would take some time. Therefore, Sri	Contd...

		T. Venkataiah has temporarily agreed to allow the drainage water to pass through his private land. 4. The Written Instructions would also indicate that the Petitioner, who is a neighbour of Sri T. Venkataiah, is objecting to the free flow of water through the temporarily laid drainage in Sri T. Venkataiah's private land. However, the Representation of the Petitioner dated 30.03.2026 (Ex.P.5) would indicate that Sri T. Venkataiah, after initially allowing the drainage water to flow freely through his premises, has later objected and caused blockage, thereby leading to inundation in the neighbourhood due to the drainage water. 5. The Photographs (Ex.P.1) at Page Nos.14 to 17 provide a sordid picture of the situation, showing that the drainage water has been freely flowing in the neighbourhood. This Court notices that there is a danger of spreading of communicable diseases due to this situation. 6. In this view of the matter, there shall be a direction to the Respondent Authorities to immediately clear the obstruction, if any, laid by Sri T. Venkataiah, to allow the drainage water to flow freely, and also to ensure that the inundated water is evacuated. It is clarified that this arrangement is purely temporary and that the Respondent Officials shall take immediate steps	Contd...
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		to construct proper drainage on public land and hand over the area occupied by the temporary drainage back to Sri T. Venkataiah within ninety (90) days from today. 7. Respondent Nos.2 & 3 are directed to clear the obstruction, if any, in the temporary drainage and not only allow but also ensure the free flow of drainage water. 8. The Respondents shall submit a Report by the next date as regards the proposed action for construction of a proper Drainage System, which shall also include information with regard to the Allocation of Budget. 9.
