The learned Counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. Initially, Respondent No.2 lodged a complaint, which was registered as a case in Crime No.70 of 2023 on 07.02.2023 for the alleged offence punishable under Section 427 of the IPC. Subsequently, Respondent No.2 instituted a suit in O.S. No.726 of 2025 on the file of the learned II Additional Junior Civil Judge, Kadapa; however, the suit was dismissed on merits. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation. Sri Arrabolu Sai Naveen, learned Counsel, is appointed as trained Mediator in this case. The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary	<i>contd...</i>

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		proceedings in this regard. The learned Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned shall refer the parties to mediation on 05.05.2026 for an amicable settlement of the dispute. The mediator shall submit a report after the Summer Vacation, 2026. Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.2016 of 2025 on the file of the learned Special Judicial Magistrate of First Class (Prohibition & Excise), Kadapa. <u>Dr.YLR, J</u> KMS
