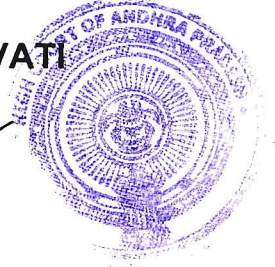

The Station House Officer concerned and learned Trial Court is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator. ✓

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.554 of 2024 on the file of the learned Additional Junior Civil Judge, Srikalahasthi. ✓

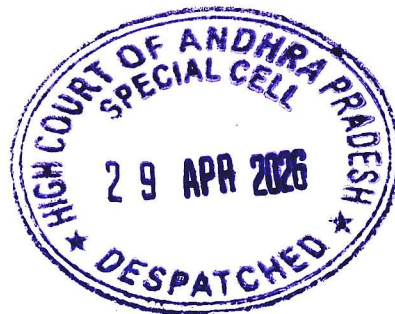
