Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ or order more particularly one in nature of writ of MANDAMUS declaring the action of the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> respondents in interfering with the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the land admeasuring Ac.0.40 cents in survey No.131-1 and Ac.0.68 cents in survey No.131-2 situated at Kurugunta Revenue Village, Anantapuramu Rural Mandal, Anantapuramu District without issuing any notice or following due procedure contemplated under law as illegal, arbitrary, and against the principles of natural justice;

**IA NO: 1 OF 2019:**

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> respondents not to interfere with the petitioner's peaceful possession and enjoyment of the land admeasuring Ac.0.40 cents in survey No.131-1 and Ac.0.68 cents in survey No.131-2 situated at Kurugunta Revenue Village, Anantapuramu Rural Mandal, Anantapuramu District, without following due procedure of law, pending disposal of WP.No.8257 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Seshadri Goalla, Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Revenue for Respondents, the Court made the following;

**ORDER:**

**The learned Assistant Government Pleader is directed to secure instructions with regard to the possession of the petitioner regarding the land admeasuring Ac.0-40 cents in Survey No.131-1 and Ac.0-68 cents in Survey No.131-2 situated at Kurugunta Revenue Village, Anantapuramu Rural Mandal, Anantapuramu District.**

**The matter is to be posted on 09.04.2026.**

**Failing to secure these instructions, the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent – Revenue Divisional Officer shall appear before this Court.**
